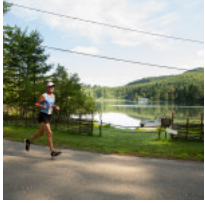

Saranac Lake Village Farmers' Market Sat, Aug 15th, 9:00am



Summer Market: Riverside Park every Saturday from June to mid-October. 9 a.m. - 10 a.m for seniors ONLY 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. for everyone Shopping Guidance Market Safety for Shoppers Masks: All shoppers must wear a face covering inside the market space. 6 foot rule: Maintain a 6' distance between yourself, volunteers, farm stand employees, and other customers. One way traffic: Please enter the market at the corner of Main and River Street and follow the signs. Get in and out: Try to keep your market shopping trip as quick as possible. No dogs or bikes: Please do not bring your dogs or bikes into the market. Small groups only: Limit your party to 1-2 people and split up to finish shopping quickly. Healthy customers only: If you're sick, please stay home. No touching: Do not pick up any products or produce at the farm stands, ask an employee to help you. No samples of food or drink at the market. Wash your hands: Thoroughly wash your hands often with soap for at least 20 seconds. If hand washing is not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer. Don't touch your face. Wash your produce and your bags: Wash all produce thoroughly before using it. Regularly wash your reusable produce bags. What Our Vendors Are Doing All producers must wear masks and protective gloves Adding fencing and lines to keep shoppers at least 6 feet apart Separating farm stand spaces with at least 15 feet of distance between the tents All farm stands must not use cloth tables cloths (unless covered by plastic or vinyl) All producers will be sanitizing their stands regularly, primarily wiping down tables, terminals, cash boxes, etc.. All volunteers and producers must stay home if they are sick All staff processing credit/debit/snap transactions must wear protective gloves We will provide additional hand sanitizers throughout the market Fresh Off the Farm The only "producer-only" farmers' markets in the eastern Adirondacks. At "producer-only" markets, the vendors can sell only items that they or their employees produce. Producer-only markets not only insure integrity for you, the consumer, but also provide an environment that encourages local farmers and artisans to expand and diversify their production. Our farmers all follow organic or sustainable production practices. The small farms movement is taking over in the Adirondacks and we couldn't be happier. All four seasons bring different local products to the table, whether it's luscious heirloom tomatoes in the height of summer or hearty root vegetables in the depths of winter. People come together for good, fresh food from the producers. The farmers markets are more than just food, though. They are spaces where community and travelers alike come out for live music, local art, and of course, locally grown food. It's fun for the whole family and a great way to experience the Adirondacks!
